Ride or Drive to Performances at SDSU

BY CAR:

Parking at SDSU:

All cars (even those with ADA placards/plates) need an SDSU parking permit to park in student or visitor spaces.

- Save time and money by purchasing a parking permit <u>prior</u> to driving to campus.
 Through the <u>Aztec Parking Portal</u>, create a guest account, purchase the \$6/day permit and place the printed permit on your dash once parked in a student parking structure.
- Permits can also be **purchased on campus** at the top level of parking structure 12 for \$3/hour, or via PayByPhone app (download prior to arriving on campus).

Getting to Parking Structure 12:

- From I-8.College Ave. turn right at the first traffic light south of I-8 onto Canyon Crest Drive. Follow the road around to the left and up a long hill.
- At the top of the hill, turn right at the stop sigh.
- The entrance to PS12 will be on your right.
- Visitor parking is permitted on levels 3 8.
- Don't forget to place your parking permit on your dashboard.

Once parked:

- Take the stairs or elevator to the 8th (top) floor and cross the pedestrian bridge following the signs to Performing Arts Plaza (not Viejas Arena).
- The box office is located on the right side of Performing Arts Plaza.

BY TROLLEY

The GREEN LINE stops at SDSU. Exit the station and follow the path up the walkway. Turn left and pass in front of the Open Air Amphitheatre. Walk directly across Campanile Walk and it's grassy center (look for the large outdoor sculpture). The box office and entrance to the theatre are located on Performing Arts Plaza across from the Theatre building.
